Sealed Bids for Wastewater Treatment Plant Improvements, Contract 1, will be received by the Village of Beaver, at the Water Treatment Plant, State Route 335, Beaver, Ohio 45613, until 4:00 p.m. local time, during a Board of Public Affairs meeting on March 15, 2018, at which time they will be publicly opened and read. Bids are to be hand delivered between 3:00 and 4:00 p.m. on the 15<sup>th</sup>. The Water Treatment Plant is a masonry fenced-in structure located just south of Village on the west side of SR 335.

In general, the work consists of replacing three aeration blowers, clarifier improvements, new UV system, new sewage pumps, filter media replacement, and new generator automatic transfer switch. The Engineer's estimate for construction is \$500,000.00.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and Guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.

Attention of bidders is call to all requirements contained in this bid packet. General requirements are contained in the Additional Supplementary Conditions and include Equal Opportunity Requirements, Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Utilization, Debarment, the Violating Facilities Clause, and the use of Small Business in Rural Areas. Davis-Bacon (Federal) Prevailing Wage Determinations must be used.

Attention of bidders is called to the Buy American Requirements pertaining to iron and steel products.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small business in rural areas (SBRAs).

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 90 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
