**CONTRACT 3B, 2018**

Sealed Bids for Water Transmission and Force Main Lines, Contract 3B, will be received by the City of St. Marys, Ohio, at the Municipal Building, 101 East Spring, St. Marys, Ohio 45885, until 11:00 a.m., local time, on April 5, 2018 at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the work consist of the construction of approximately 4,800 feet of 4-inch force main and approximately 8,400 feet of 12-inch water transmission main. Approximately 640 feet of the 12-inch water main shall be installed by trenchless methods under 5 creek and ditch crossings. The Engineer's Estimate for total construction is \$1,425,000.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and Guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.


Attention of bidders is call to all the requirements contained in this bid packet. General requirements are contained in the Additional Supplementary Conditions and include Equal Opportunity Requirements, Minority and Woman's Business Enterprise Utilization, Debarment, the Violating Facilities Clause, and the use of Small Businesses in Rural Areas. Davis-Bacon (Federal) Prevailing Wage Determinations must be used.

Attention of bidders is called to the Buy American Requirements pertaining to iron and steel products.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small businesses in rural areas (SBRAs).

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 90 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept and Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
