Sealed Bids for Water Treatment Plant, Contract 3A, will be received by the City of St. Marys, at the Municipal Building, 101 E. Spring Street, St. Marys, Ohio 45885, until 11:30 a.m., local time, on April 5, 2018, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the work consists of a new 2.4 mgd lime-soda ash softening water treatment plant, two 375,000 gallon clearwells, and associated site work. The Engineer's estimate for total construction is \$16,800,000.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish satisfactory Performance Bond and Maintenance and Guarantee Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.


Attention of bidders is called to all the requirements contained in this bid packet. General requirements are contained in the Additional Supplementary Conditions and include Equal Opportunity Requirements, Minority and Woman's Business Enterprise Utilization, Debarment, the Violating Facilities Clause, and the use of Small Businesses in Rural Areas. Davis-Bacon (Federal) Prevailing Wage Determinations must be used.

Attention of bidders is called to the Buy American Requirements pertaining to iron and steel products.

This procurement is subject to the EPA policy of encouraging the participation of small businesses in rural areas (SBRAs).

Any Bid may be withdrawn prior to the scheduled closing time for receipt of Bids, but no bidder shall withdraw his Bid within 90 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed most favorable to the Owner.
